

II. LANDING PAGE

Using the web address www.juf.org/jhelp will bring you to a page on the JFMC website as shown below. This landing page offers information on the J-HELP project and the JFMC-affiliated agencies involved in the project.

- When you click on one of the four J-HELP categories you will see a list of questions that help the user understand which category best meets his or her needs.
- Each category also has links so the user may go directly to a variety of other helpful resources websites, or to the community resource on-line website itself.
- On the right hand side of the J-Help webpage users can connect to the entire community resource on-line database directly.
- In addition, the Community Education Events link goes to a list of upcoming J-HELP education workshops or events.
